TITLE:

Cat Socialization Volunteer AC-CS

MAJOR OBJECTIVE:

Cat Socialization volunteers provide interaction by brushing, and playing with the cats and kittens to relieve the stress and boredom that comes with being in the cattery, as well as to make them comfortable being around humans.

RESPONSIBILITIES:

3. Ability to work independently

1. Attend MSRPAC's volunteer general informational session
2. Interview with the Volunteer Services manager or designee.

TIME AND PLACE:

Shifts available every day.

COMMITMENT:

Minimum of six months commitment to the volunteer program

SUPERVISION:

Direct supervision Adoption Counselor Lead, Adoption Counselors and the Director of Operations indirect supervision by the Volunteer Services manager
