

VOLUNTEER POSITION DESCRIPTION BEHAVIOR

TITLE:

Advanced Dog Walker BH-ADW

MAJOR OBJECTIVE:

To provide dogs that are categorized "red" with exercise and appropriate elimination opportunities by walking them outside of the kennel. To assist the behavior staff in reinforcing basic training behaviors, socialization skills and self-control exercises to center dogs. The Dog Walking Program's objective is to help the center's dogs be more manageable, more adoptable and more likely to stay in their new homes.

RESPONSIBILITIES:

- 1. Following established procedures, work with center dogs by walking them and reinforcing basic behaviors, confidence and self-control.
- 2. Work with Center's Dog Behaviorist to facilitate behavior plans.
- 3. Log experiences while walking center dogs
- 4. Provide enrichment items for dogs after walks.
- 5. Read and follow all posted door signs, wearing all personal protective equipment (PPE).

QUALIFICATIONS:

- 1. Comfort working with dogs
- 2. Complete 6 months or 60 hours of walking dogs in dog walking
- 3. Minimum 18 years of age

TRAINING:

- 1. Attend MSRPAC's volunteer general informational session and round robin dog socialization session
- 2. Interview with Volunteer Services Manager or designee

TIME AND PLACE:

Shifts available during regular hours of operation.

COMMITMENT:

Minimum of one hour per week for six months

SUPERVISION:

Direct supervision by the Center Behaviorist and/or Director of Operations. Indirect supervision by the Volunteer Services manager or coordinator.
